All the staff would like to thank Per and Lindsay Andersson for this informative trip.

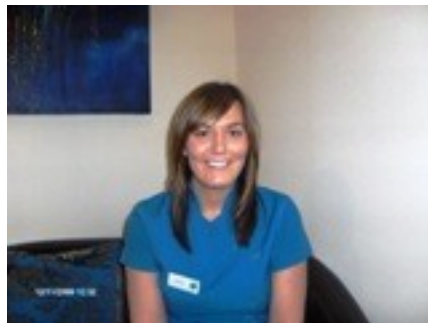
